NOMINATIONS: Received by 5pm on Tues 27th August.

EXHIBITS: Received at the Agriculture Pavilion by 8am on Show Day.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

CASH TROPHIES: Awarded for Highest and Second Highest Aggregate Points in Section.

CASH TROPHY: Champion Fleece

SASH: Champion Fleece, other than Rams fleece.

PRIZE MONEY PER CLASS: 1st \$8 2nd \$4

Special Regulations:

- Fleeces must have been shorn since the last Chapman Valley Agricultural Show.
- Do not enter sheep enclosure or address the judge while judging is in place.
- Patrons must not interfere with score cards attached to exhibits.

Method of Judging:

All exhibits will be judged on the below:

- Greasy Fleece Weight
- Vegetable Matter
- Yield

Additionally, exhibits will be judged out of 100 points according to the following scale.

Clean Fleece Weight 30 pts

Actual clean fleece weight (Kg)

Hauteur 5 pts

Average length of fibre in combed wool top.

Soundness 15 pts

The measured mean staple strength throughout the fleece (N/KT)

Character 15 pts

Evenness and well defined crimp formation

Handle 10 pts

Softness and pliancy applicable to type

Colour 5 pts

The possession of those characteristics or top grading from a whiteness-style point of view.

Length 10 pts

The measured mean staple length throughout the fleece

Evenness 10 pts

The evenness of fibre diameter throughout the fleece as measured by the co-efficient of variation of fibre diameter (%).

Class 42 Two Fleeces, fine wool

Class 43 Single Fleece, strong wool

Class 44 Single Fleece, medium wool

Class 45 Single Fleece, fine wool

Class 46 Single Rams Fleece, strong wool

Class 47 Single Rams Fleece, medium wool

Class 48 Single Rams Fleece, fine wool

Class 49 Wool from one Merino lamb, 1kg in weight

Class 50 One Fleece other than Rams judged for commercial value, unskirted belly included
